


<p>Instruct others in how to save a life</p> <p style="text-align: center;"></p> <p>Teach First Aid and CPR classes Time commitment: 28 hours of training and commit to times that are convenient for you</p>	<p>Educate kindergarten and first grades on the importance of hand-washing</p> <p style="text-align: center;"></p> <p>Use the Scrubby Bear program to teach school age children Time commitment: 4 hours of training and able to teach class during school hours.</p>
